The Monmouth-Independence Community Foundation is offering a minimum of four, \$1,500 scholarships to students who will be attending, full-time, an institution offering post-high school academic degree programs or an institution offering post-high school vocational or technical training. Applicants must graduate from high school in 2020.

Your application should include:

1. Completed application form.
2. A completed request for an Unofficial Transcript signed by you.
3. A schedule of your classes for the second semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
4. A copy of your application confirmation from the college, university or trade school you wish to attend.

General criteria for the Monmouth-Independence Community Foundation awards are: grades, school activities, community service, academic profile (the courses that you completed) and your personal statement.

**APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED ONLY IF ALL PARTS OF THE APPLICATION ARE LEGIBLE, COMPLETE AND ALL NECESSARY FORMS AND DOCUMENTS ARE FILED WITH THE CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE BY APRIL 3, 2020.**

**The scholarship must be used during the 2020-2021 academic year.**
